



**Pheasants Forever Calgary Announces Dr. Ted Morton as  
the 2014 Dinner Chairman**

The Board of Directors of PF Calgary are pleased to announce that Dr. Ted Morton will serve as Dinner Chairman at the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Fundraising Dinner and Auction on April 23, 2014 at the BMO Center, Stampede Park.

Ted is currently a Senior Fellow, Energy and Environment, at the Manning Foundation; an Executive Fellow at The School of Public Policy and Professor of Political Science at the University of Calgary.

Dr. Morton most recently served as Minister of Energy for the Government of Alberta (2011-12). Prior to that, he served as Minister of Finance (2010) and Minister of Sustainable Resources Development (2006-2009).

As Alberta's Minister of Sustainable Research Development, Dr. Morton oversaw the development of Alberta's Land Use Framework (2008) and the passage of the Alberta Land Stewardship Act (2009). As Minister, he increased Alberta's participation in the Robert Bateman Get-to-Know Your Wild Neighbors project; opened the Bow Habitat Station in Calgary (2010) and was the Founding Committee Chair of the Kids Can Catch Trout Pond\_ (officially opened in 2012). An avid outdoorsman, Dr. Morton has a long-record of supporting habitat conservation as the key to maintaining wildlife and fisheries. He is a member of Ducks Unlimited, Trout Unlimited, Pheasants Forever, Delta Waterfowl, and the Pacific Salmon Foundation.

We welcome Ted on board and all of us on the Dinner Committee look forward to working with him in preparation of the 2014 Fundraising Campaign.
