Gordon Ritchie has been with RBC Capital Markets for 35 years and currently holds the position of Vice Chairman. From 2001 through 2005, Gordon served as Managing Director and Head of the Global E&P Energy Group. Previously, Gordon spent six years in New York where he served as President and Chief Executive Officer of RBC's U.S. Broker/Dealer Operations (1993 to 1999); was co-Head of RBC's International Corporate Finance Group based in London, England (1989 to 1993); and, has extensive experience in investment banking in Europe, the United States and Canada.

Gordon has been active with a wide range of not-for-profits since returning to Calgary in 1999. He Co-Chaired the 2003 Calgary and Area United Way Campaign and served as Board Chair in 2005. Gordon is Past Board Chair of WinSport Canada (formerly Calgary Olympic Development Association) where he served on the Board and Chaired its Investment Committee for a decade. Gordon is very proud to have been a member of the team that fully recapitalized WinSport's assets during this period, including the new Athletic & Ice Complex at Canada Olympic Park, and a built a strong Endowment Fund to preserve the 88 Olympic Legacy.

Today, Gordon is Vice Chair of the Board of Governors of the University of Calgary, Chairs the Investment Committee of the Board of UofC, sits on the Board of Gemini Corporation and a private family holding company. Gordon and his wife Robyn are active with the Banff Centre for the Arts, Hull Child and Family Services, Right to Play, TransCanada Trail and Canada Company.

Gordon's outside interests include golf, skiing, hunting, fishing and spending time with family and friends.
